IMPORTANT INFORMATION ON ADMISSION TO THE FAIR!



Please observe! The new process for admission to the trade fair. What do you have to do as an exhibitor?

THIS IS NEW:

Instead of the usual exhibitor and work passes in paper form, you have received digital admission ticket codes for an exhibitor pass from us per e-mail. Please forward on these codes to all people, who require admission to spoga+gafa:

- Colleagues, who are manning your exhibition stand (for exhibitor passes)
- Your stand construction team (for work passes assembly/dismantling)
- Further service providers you have commissioned in the scope of your trade fair presence (for work passes)

Admission to the trade fair occurs in three simple steps:



1. Redeem your digital admission ticket code:

Every person, who requires admission to the fair, has to redeem his/her
admission ticket code in the Ticket Shop in the run-up to spoga+gafa and
create a personal Koelnmesse account (which applies for the registration
via spoga+gafa and for the digital platform of spoga+gafa).

2. Download the spoga+gafa app:

- This year exclusively digital admission tickets are being issued. It is thus
 necessary for you to download the spoga+gafa app, which is available
 from mid-may from the App Store or from the Play Store.
- After registering in the app using the log-in data from your Koelnmesse account, your admission ticket will be displayed automatically. (Note: It can take up to 10 minutes for the ticket to be displayed after the order has been completed.)

3. You arrive at spoga+gafa:

- You will be granted access to the fair grounds on presenting the admission ticket in the spoga+gafa app.
- If you have a ticket for spoga+gafa you can also use the digital platform.

 You can log in using your access data from your Koelnmesse account.
- The Covid restrictions for trade fairs and events in North Rhine-Westphalia were lifted in April 2022. However, Koelnmesse strongly recommends that you only enter the exhibition centre if you have been vaccinated against, have recently recovered from or have tested negative for Covid, and that you voluntarily wear a medical mouth nose protection.
